Eligibility Requirements

- Have graduated from high school in 1 of these 5 counties: Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie, Niagara. *Non-traditional students must have established residency for at least 12 months.*
- Are attending a degree program in 1 of the 5 counties.
- Intend to practice in NYS upon graduation.
- Are a first-generation and/or low-income student.

Frequently asked questions

- **When will I hear back?** After you submit an online application, we will contact you with next steps.
- **When is the application deadline?** Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
- **How long will the program provide assistance?** We aim to provide assistance for the duration of your program.
- **How will I know exactly what the financial aid money will be covering?** We will conduct a needs assessment with each student to determine how the funds will best benefit the student.
- **How will the life skills training be conducted?** The training will be offered synchronously and asynchronously through an online learning platform.

What the program offers

- Financial support to reduce financial barriers for students through tuition and cost-of-living assistance.
- A mentoring program to foster a supportive environment that aids in the personal and professional development of students.
- Life-skills training to aid students in achieving academic success.
- Case management and mental health services to offer holistic support to help students navigate personal, academic, and financial challenges.
